Working with Trees and Shrubs

Caution should be used when considering the use of the *Bradford Pear* or *White Pine* trees that have been removed from the property. You are invited to research these species and determine why they should notbe restored.

Aesculus pavia Red buckeye

Red buckeye is a clump-forming shrub or small tree that typically grows 10-20' tall. Showy 4-10" long panicles of red to orange-red tubular flowers appear in spring and attract hummingbirds. Shiny, dark green leaves are attractive in spring and early summer, but usually begin to decline by August. Seeds are poisonous and are avoided by most wildlife.



Magnolia tripetala Umbrella tree

The long, shiny green leaves (24" long and to 10" wide) of this deciduous magnolia appear in whorl-like clusters at the stem tips, purportedly resembling the spokes of an umbrella. It is a small (30'tall) understory tree that is often multi-trunked. Large, malodorous but showy, creamy white flowers (6-10" across) bloom in spring shortly after the leaves emerge. Flowers are followed by cone-like pink fruits that ripen in fall



Cladrastis kentukea Yellowwood

Excellent, low- maintenance, small shade tree (30-50' tall) for residential lawns, particularly on smaller properties. The roots go deep, so other plants may beeasily grown underneath. It features intensely fragrant, wisteria- like, white flowers inclusters 10-15" longthat virtually cover amature tree in late spring. Good yellowfall color.

Lombardi Poplar



Lombardy poplars are high-maintenance trees. They create a mess, dropping leaves and twigs that must be swept regularly to keep the area around the tree neat. Due to the tree's brittle wood, branches also break and drop off easily during rough weather. The roots are invasive and can clog pipes, lift sidewalks, and invade lawns. Young suckers may emerge at the base of the tree or above roots. In fact, the Missouri Botanical Garden states that Lombardy poplar is not a good landscape tree
